

BOIL WATER ADVISORY

To consumers of the Port Burwell Water System

The Municipality of Bayham is advising that once water supply has been restored that the users of the water bring water to a rolling boil for at least one minute prior to using it for domestic purposes e.g. drinking, making infant formula and juice, brushing teeth, washing raw foods and making ice.

The reason for the advisory is that the Municipality is replacing components of the said water system that may result in bacterial contamination of the water.

This advisory measure is in place as a precaution until such time as bacteriological tests prove the water to be safe. You will be notified at that time that the boil water advisory has been lifted.
