**DECISION** 

**THAT** the Committee of Adjustment Secretary/Treasurer's report DS-07/24 regarding the Roy Schrijver Farms Ltd. minor variance be received;

**AND THAT** the Committee of Adjustment considered all written and oral submissions received on this application, the effect of which helped the committee to make an informed decision;

**AND WHEREAS** the Committee agrees that the proposed variance as presented meets Section 45.1(1) of the Planning Act and is considered minor;

**THEREFORE** application A-03/24 submitted by Roy Schrijver Farms Ltd. pursuant to Section 45 of the Planning Act for a minor variance, is granted to allow relief from Municipality of Bayham Zoning By-law No. Z456-2003:

Section 5.2 <u>Permitted Uses</u> - to permit the conversion of an existing two-storey single-detached dwelling of 240 m2 (2,583.3 sq. ft.) in gross floor area to a Supplementary Farm Dwelling to accommodate a maximum of ten (10) seasonal farm labourers in the existing permanent building for the time period between April 1<sup>st</sup> and November 30<sup>th</sup>, subject to the owner entering into a Development Agreement with the Municipality.

Condition: A Development Agreement to be executed within six (6) months of the minor variance approval.
